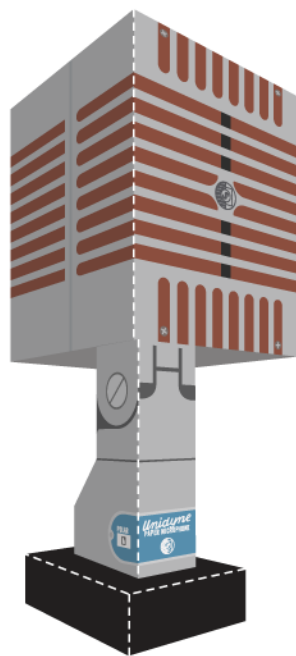


PAPER MICROPHONE ASSEMBLY KIT

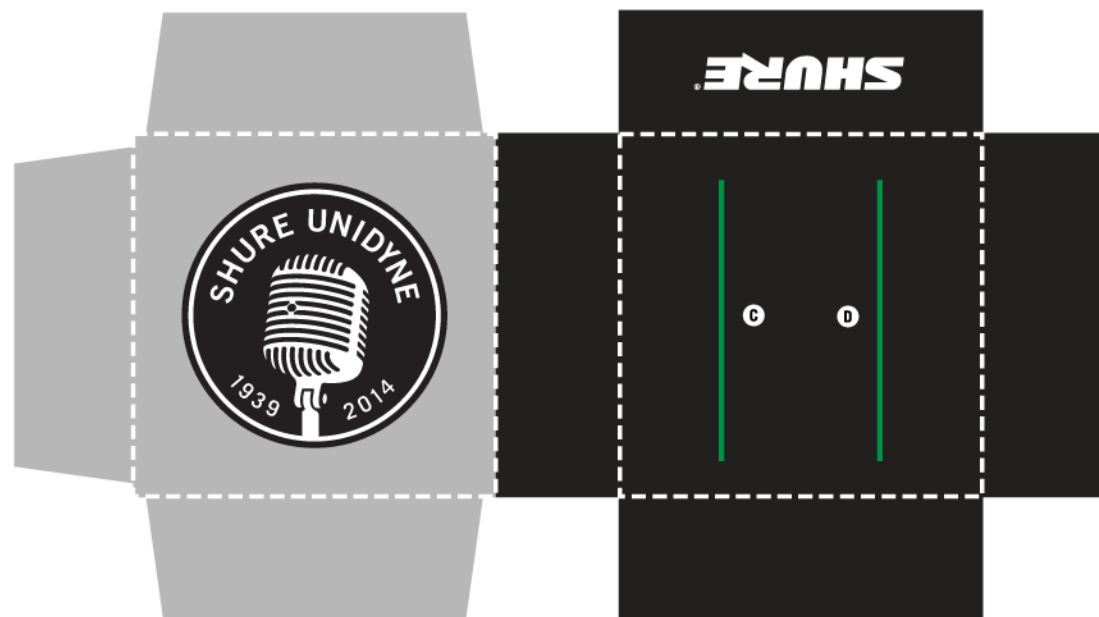

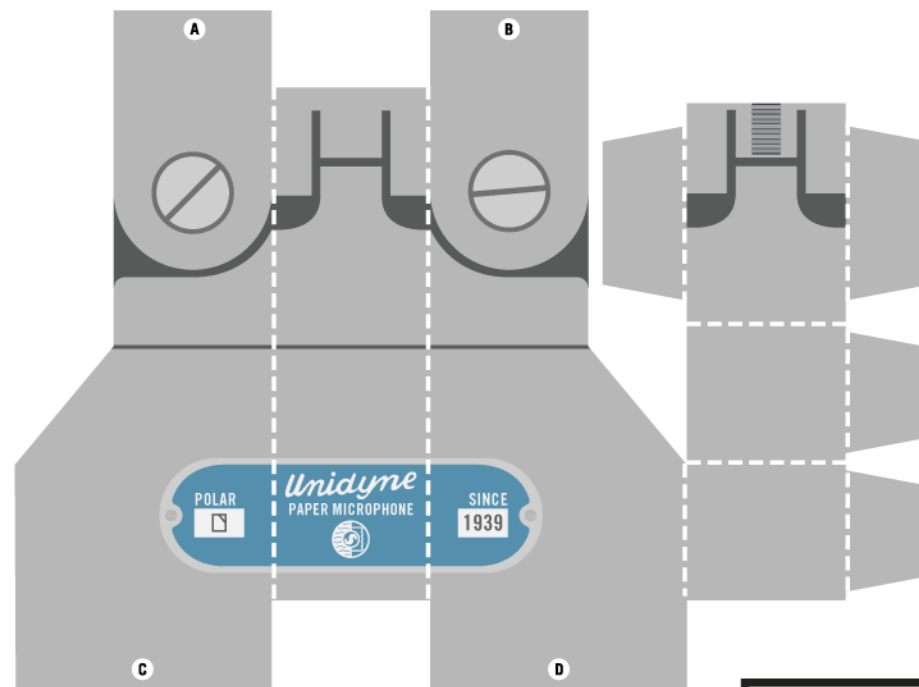
FINISHED EXAMPLE

ASSEMBLY NOTES

1. Thick paper or card stock is recommended
2. Carefully cut along exterior (Hobby knives work best)
3. Cut slits at green-marked lines
4. Fold along dotted lines
5. Use double-sided tape or glue to adhere tabs to the insides
6. Match letters to attach head, neck, and base of mic
7. Have fun!



MICROPHONE BASE



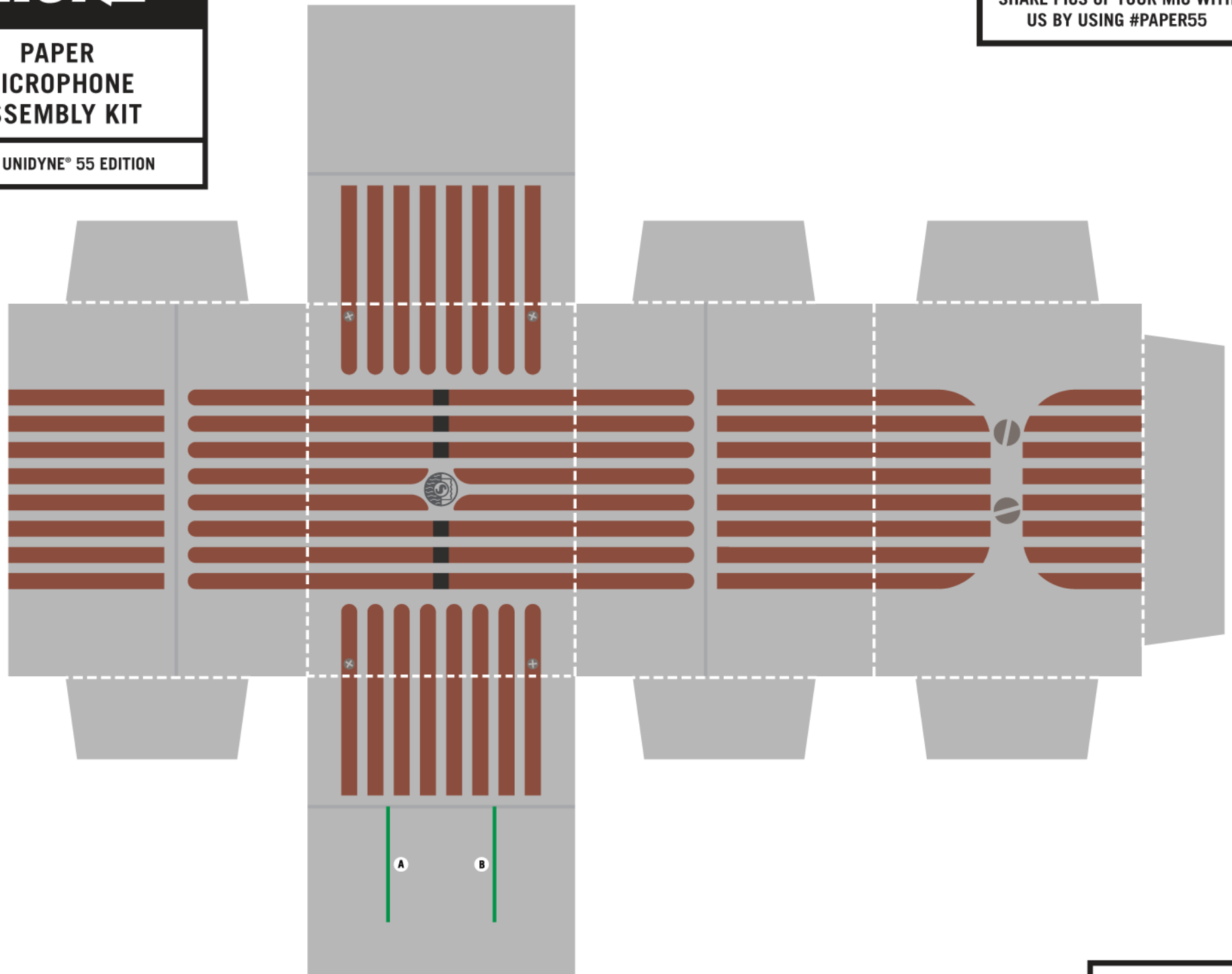
MICROPHONE NECK
